Mission Spot-Wycliffe Foundation



Wycliffe Australia exists to see disciples of Jesus growing through the scriptures available in the language that speaks to their hearts. We send Australian Christians and support national organisations involved in the Bible translation movement." On their site are many inspiring stories. Here is an abbreviated one that I hope has you thirsting for what God is up to with Wycliffes projects.

In March 2019, Sentani was ravaged by severe flooding and landslides. Hundreds of lives were lost and thousands of families lost their homes. Two of the worst hit areas happened close to the Hillcrest International School and our Papuan Malay translation office. Several thousand people whose houses were washed away in the villages below sought refuge in these locations. In the days that followed, these people experienced the love of Christ in very practical ways. The mission community, along with church, government and local organisations, provided food, shelter, medical care and a listening ear to those who had lost everything. After the fourth straight day of rain, people began to gather to worship God publicly. Even before the storm was over, they chose to praise God, anchor their hope in Him, and trust in Him for deliverance.

Reportable Conduct—Update

There are new requirements for churches for mandatory reporting of conduct that is harmful to children.

All employees (including volunteers and contractors) must report the allegation or conviction to the Senior Pastor (or to the Children's Guardian if it relates to the Senior Pastor) who must inform the Office of the Children's Guardian within 7 days. Our current training and systems already encourage such concerns to be reported. **THE KEY DIFFERENCE NOW IS THAT IT IS A LEGAL REQUIREMENT.**

There is a brief introduction and fact sheet, 'Identifying Reportable Allegations', available in the admin section of our web-site and hard copies can be found in the foyer. Please familiarise yourself with this material.
