


# Easter at Home A guided reflection



that even if we ignore him, he doesn't ignore us.

Say sorry to Jesus for the times you have turned your back on him.




"It was our weaknesses he carried. It was our sorrows that weighed him down." Isaiah 53:4

### Reflection

Our weaknesses and sorrows were heavy for Jesus to carry, but He carried them willingly.

### Reflection Jesus died in our place.

Spend time confessing your rebellion and sin (the ways you have lived opposite to God's best way of living).
