In this changing world, some things don't change. As we all reflect on what the future might look like on the other side of this pandemic and plan to make it as good as possible – we need 2 things: We need to be brave and courageous to embrace change for the better. And we need to be completely clear about the things that won't and shouldn't change. If we can be clear about these things, that frees us to change other things. That's *why today we're launching into a series on 7 fundamentals for Christians.*

For this we're going to follow a series of bible studies called **Just for Starters**. It's often used with new believers, but *all of us* benefit from revisiting the basics of biblical belief and living – reminding ourselves of the things that don't change, especially as we step bravely into the future. Today our topic is **Saved by God**. So let me ask you this: **One day when you stand before God, why would God accept you?** What do you think? Does that question make you uneasy? It's actually a normal Christian experience to have doubts. But here's the good news: the Bible gives us a really great answer to that question, and that's exactly what we're going to look at today. In Romans 5:8-9 we learn that it's all about grace. It doesn't depend on us earning or deserving God's approval in any way. It's all about what God has done for us through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Not only are they isolated and discriminated for their faith, but Christians are often the last to receive medical supplies and emergency relief. "This morning we discovered that Christian nurses are being assigned Corona cases because it's dangerous, and the Muslim nurses don't want the risk. We are dispensable"- Sarah*, a nurse working in a Muslim majority country in Asia. Praise God that church communities including Carlingford have still given attention, prayer and supported financially global mission amongst the challenges of this time.
