What are the things that are leading you to feel anxious at the moment?

There are probably many – all the normal things plus everything associated with this pandemic!

Today is the 5th week of our series from *Just For Starters* – 7 fundamentals of our faith that don't change, even at this time when so much *is* changing around us – and our focus today is on *talking to God*, or prayer.

In Philippians 4:6-7, the apostle Paul is approaching the end of his letter when he encourages his readers to pray. There's a little bit about *how* to pray, and a *promise* for when they do pray. Interestingly, he starts by telling them not to be anxious. We've just been thinking about all the reasons we might be anxious! Here's an encouragement, not to feel guilty about something that is a normal part of being human, or over which we might not have any control, but to know that we can take all these things that might weigh us down, to the God who is bigger than our problems, and who loves and cares for us. He doesn't promise to take all our problems away, but he promises us the peace of knowing he will never abandon us.

How amazing that God would want us to relate to him in prayer!

The Home School Principal Kawshala's husband Mr Nayon Gilbert Rozario passed away Monday 6th July with the virus. Another Home School teacher Sufia and her family members are doing well and they are now all negative. Some of the Home kids have returned to the Children's Home because they don't have enough food at their single parent's home and some parents have lost their jobs. There are more kids returning to the home because of their needs. At present there are 65 children at the Home and all of them are doing well and so are the staff. David asks us to pray for all of them, Namita, Mark, Anila and David's little granddaughter Vanessa.
