Are you familiar with that problem in church life where someone starts out keen to serve sacrificially for God but over time something changes? Maybe it's due to the constant busy-ness they experience, the never-ending demands, no time to rest until they end up exhausted, disillusioned, maybe bitter and twisted, even burnt out! Maybe this has even been your experience, to some extent. It's all too common.

We choose to serve in response to God's amazing love for us, inspired by the wonder of a God who chooses to work through broken people like you and me. It should be so good, and yet somehow, sometimes it goes horribly wrong.

Today as we turn to 1 Samuel 6 we find a strange little story that helps us in this. It does this by showing us that God's purposes aren't ultimately dependent on you or me; his power *will* prevail. God isn't constrained by my contribution or yours. Even if we fail to cooperate or even deny him, he is God! May God speak to us through his word today, helping us to grow in our maturity in service to him.

Mission Spot



COVID-19 continues to wreak havoc across Africa, with countries like the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) dealing with the devastating effects of the disease across the country. In desperate need of testing kits & protective equipment to deal with the growing outbreak (the first case was in early June), Dr. Denis Mukwege (Noble Prize winner) at Panzi Hospital put out a call for help. Many patients with respiratory problems had been admitted, many of whom were dying immediately on arrival because they had sought help too late. The staff needed help with tests to ensure the safety of staff and patients to determine who needed to be isolated at the hospital.

By God's grace, all the moving parts of sourcing and transporting the equipment and tests came together. The material was sent via Entebbe and with the help of the team at MAF Uganda, flown onto the hospital in Bukava. In South Sudan for some months COVID-19 travel restrictions had prohibited MAF from flying people-even critical medical flights were not permitted. Restrictions eased in mid-May allowing an elderly woman with very painful, severely broken leg (sustained 3 weeks earlier) to be flown to Juba for medical intervention & a slow recovery. *"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God has prepared in advance for us to do."* Ephesians 2:10

UPDATE FROM THE ELDERS
