# Global Interaction

Teammates Sally Pim and Ben Good reflect on their story telling experiences in Mozambique and pluck out key questions we should ask ourselves before we start sharing the story that changes the world. "It's not as simple as rocking up Bible in hand and telling our favourite Bible story. So how can we share this story that has the power to transform lives through Jesus? Three more questions that help the Gospel make sense in your context:

Who are you sharing the story with? What is the world view of the person you are connecting with? Do they sit within a predominant culture of honour/shame, power/fear, or guilt/innocence? Do they believe in the existence of a higher power? What do they value? Justice, logic, self-reliance, family, tradition. Local stories give a good indication as to what is valued in a culture.

How will you share the story? How do people communicate in this context? Is it different to the culture you carry?

Will you listen to what they share? It is fair to assume that we are not always going to draw the same conclusions as others and therefore need to be aware of the influences of our own

ers and therefore need to be aware of the influences of our own background. We are always better for encountering Jesus' story together rather than in isolation. When we do, we discover that Jesus is bigger than our individual understanding of him."
