Words have an enormous power for good or evil. How often have we been about to give up when someone has encouraged us just when we needed it? Or someone has spoken to us harshly and we have felt worthless and crushed in spirit? Words make a difference to us all. Our words too can make a difference for others. Research shows the average person speaks at least 7,000 words a day. For many of us it is more. Think about what that means for you. Those 7,000 words are your imprint on the world. What imprint are we making?

The Bible say a lot about our words. They can pop out without us thinking. We need to daily pray with the Psalmist, "Set a guard over my mouth, O Lord; Keep watch over the door of my lips." Proverbs has lots of wisdom for us to learn about our words. So today we will look at over 30 proverbs to help us do good, not harm, with our words. We need to ask ourselves, What imprint are my words making on this world? Is our imprint one of wisdom, healing, gentleness, nourishment, grace, discernment, soothing, kindness & joy? Or do we leave behind us hatred, anger, gossip, lies, dishonesty, flattery, slander & grumbling? Jesus is God's word to this world. The imprint he left on our world is enormous. Peter recognised his importance and said to Jesus, "You have the words of eternal life." May our words convey life, the life of God, to others.
