The Confession – Psalm 51

When we read and take in the breadth of the Old and New Testament we see both the brokenness and weakness of humanity contrasted with God's gracious action in bringing forgiveness, healing, and life. It is difficult to find stories of families who are functioning well – the majority have family disputes, jealousies, dysfunction. Today we look at Psalm 51 – a Psalm that is clearly placed within a key moment in David's life. David's weakness is not hidden from view, nor is his response to being confronted with his sin diluted with easy apologies and platitudes. His confession is breathtaking in its vulnerability. What is amazing is that perhaps David's weakest moment is framed forever in the prayers and songs of God's people, displaying God's willingness to respond with grace whenever we humble ourselves before Him.

Mission Spot—Baptist Care



Baptist Care has notified CBC that the former site of Yallambi Aged Care Centre has been approved for a 162-unit community housing development. It was approved by Parramatta Council & the Sydney Central City Planning Panel in December last year. This development will provide much-needed affordable housing for seniors and single-parent families facing disadvantage. Housing affordability is a critical issue in the City of Parramatta and across Greater Sydney. The Carlingford site is ideally placed given it is well serviced by public transport and is close to jobs, facilities and amenities. More than 60% of the housing will be dedicated to seniors as Baptist Care remains committed to servicing and supporting vulnerable seniors in the community. This site is significant as it is the birthplace of Baptist Care. Baptist Care's community housing is planned to include a full-time on-site Housing Manager who will be based within an office in the Community Centre, as well as a full-time Tailored Support Coordinator who will support tenants and household members with access to a range of individualised services to improve their well being and achieve their goals. Progress information is available on the webpage: baptistcare.org.au/Carlingford-development When the development is completed (expected in 2022), it is hoped that CBC can find a supportive role in the Community.
