Paul – what a powerhouse! It's probably no surprise to you that we would engage with Paul in our 'Encounters with the King' series. Paul is a well-known Christian figure who is considered to be responsible for the composition of 13 or 14 of the 27 books (in his case, letters) in the New Testament. Paul spent most of his Christian life travelling extensively, spreading the gospel, and establishing churches. He was a missionary to the Gentiles, and also to the Jews, who he met in foreign lands and eventually, tradition states, that he was martyred in Rome for his faith. His incredible contribution to the Christian faith is very well known, however it seems to me that sometimes we pass over Paul's pre-conversion and conversion story a little too swiftly and in doing so lose some of the power of his testimony and the remarkable transformation that took place after his encounter with the resurrected Jesus. Paul's conversion demonstrates for us a variety of truths about the gospel and who our God is, but none more than this: no one is beyond the saving grace of Jesus (even a man like Paul) – the gospel is for everyone!

Ministry in lockdown is challenging and many of our refugee friends find they have little work, extra challengers studying online, and feel the isolation deeply. SRT has continued to deliver food to over 30 families fortnightly (with regular requests for help). We need to assess new Covid restrictions weekly for impact on our Food parcel service. We have segregated our deliveries to be delivered by those who live in the LGA as much as possible. We can only drop the food at people's door, but sadly cannot stay to connect (as would be our normal practice). This is truly heartbreaking for us as we find that it is in the relationships that we are able to share the love and hope of Jesus. It is the time spent together in friendship that normally energises us to continue in this challenging ministry. We are endeavouring to find more creative ways to give encouragement eg. Cards and care packages.
