The body of Christ

Paul's vision of the body of Christ is of a unity which consists in diversity, that is, a unity which is not denied by diversity, but which would be denied by uniformity, a unity which depends on its diversity functioning as such – in a word the unity of a body, the body of Christ.

As we finish this short series on metaphors of the Christian church we look at the "Body of Christ" a concept that Paul explores in a number of well known passages – 1 Cor 12; Eph 4; Romans 12. Paul makes it clear that one of the defining indicators of the Body of Christ is the need for absolutely unity in the midst of great diversity. This finds expression within the context of the local church, but importantly, also within the broader framework of the universal Christian Church which finds expression in a wide variety of different traditions and practices all centred around the Lordship of Christ and Word of God revealed in the Bible. This diversity, as Dunn writes, is not a weakness, a flaw, but an expression of the broad expanse of Almighty God – indeed diversity is far more vital than uniformity which is more often to be found in religious cults.

A big thank you from our various mission partners. Over recent weeks I have had the privilege of catching up one-on-one over coffee with some of our mission partners – all of which expressed their genuine appreciation for the support of CBC – as well as discussing further opportunities to strengthen our mutual relationship:

Open Doors: Jordan Scott – with the commencement of a new youth service in 2022, under the leadership of David Chang, it is hoped that Open Doors can particularly build some worthwhile connections with our youth and young adults and expose them to the breadth of mission enterprises explored by Open Doors
Baptist World Aid – Australia: Nathan Reid – the Cambodia partnership continues to allow BWA-A to build meaningful connections with those local partners in Cambodia and see lives changed. Nathan will visit CBC in the first half of next year.

MAF: Mike Swanson – we connected by phone and Mike wanted CBC to know how they valued the MAF Father's Day support. He indicated that a praise point for MAF has been the consistent support from supporters and donors that has led to the construction of two new hangers in Queensland. International flights are now up to 60% of pre-pandemic levels. Please pray for God's provision as they look for new team members across different fields.

HELP: I had the privilege of meeting up with David for coffee and he, like our other mission partners, expressed his deep appreciation to CBC for it's communal support, but also for individual support and encouragement over many years. He values our ongoing prayer for wisdom as the organisation faces various challenges around ongoing concerns with Covid, their plans to develop a fish farm, and the need to increase teachers salaries.

CBC Christmas Appeal BWA – Afghanistan Crisis

Decades of a refugee crisis have resulted in nearly six million Afghans forcibly displaced from their homes. The Taliban's recent takeover of the government has severely compounded the crisis, forcing hundreds of thousands to flee from their homes and tens of thousands in need of urgent humanitarian assistance. Baptist World Aids response is to meet the immediate needs of displaced families in Afghanistan and Pakistan. Their local Christian partners are poised to provide critically needed emergency supplies including monthly food aid, blankets, mattresses and plastic sheets for winter protection. CBC is running a Christmas appeal for BWA for the situation in Afghanistan that will run until the end of January.
