I often think about FEBC as working in far flung and difficult places to reach both through isolation and threat of extreme discrimination against Christians. That is certainly the case but the most recent newsletter has a thankyou from a woman now living in Bundaburg QLD.

She found out about Jesus through listening to a Christian radio station when she was a child. Her family were on a farm in WA, where there was no church. Sunday service happened rarely and in someones house. "A Christian newsletter and radio Sunday School were the only ways my siblings and I received Christian content. On Sundays we would sit by the radio to listen. I would also do a workbook. The station also organised summer camps. It was in one of these camps that I was saved."

She recognises the value and impact especially during the Covid pandemic for isolated remote communities to get critical information. "The Gospel has to be heard".

February Prayer Theme - Recommitment
