Sydney Refugee Team

Food Bank training, food sorting, visiting, praying and planning continue. Karl and Caroline are in Europe, planning to return in late April. Part of the trip includes training for helping refugees with trauma.

There are many Afghans in Sydney hotels, who have not been officially referred to SRT, but see other refugees receive food from us, but they themselves do not. Please pray for God to make it possible to increase the capacity to reach more people, so we can make good connections and relationships with a greater number of new arrivals.

One strategy is to mobilise churches to establish "Church Hubs". This has started at St Marks, Berowra this month and with Mount Druitt Anglican next with training for them in May.



The Freedom to Flourish Ministry have been prospering in the garden. Some of the refugees have been learning that from brokenness can come something new. The example was making stepping stones using broken tiles and plates to make stepping stones.

Crossover supports outreach and evangelism by providing:

- Encouragement** – Because sharing the great news of God’s kingdom should be as important to the church as it is to Jesus

- Resources** – Not all of us have creative and innovative ways and words for reaching out, but some do! Crossover puts their tools in our hands.
