Today in our series on the book of James, we step back to James 3 where we consider wisdom. James compares two kinds of wisdom worldly wisdom that is based on envy and selfish ambition which is contrasted with "the wisdom that comes from heaven [which] is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere." He urges us in the church to humbly seek heavenly wisdom. James claims that if we seek this wisdom it will result in a harvest of righteousness. Rather than envy and selfish ambition, which leads to fights and guarrels, James calls on members of the church to be peace-loving and considerate of each other. As we move forward in our church health survey process and consider a suitable leadership church structure and pastoral team for the future, let's take time to listen to God and each other. Freedom to Flourish supports healing and growth for people from refugee background who have experienced trauma. They offer counselling, and therapeutic craft and garden programs.
