Although we love being spectators to lots of interesting events including Soccer World Cup qualifiers, Platinum Jubilee spectaculars or just our children or grandchildren achieving pleasing results, as Christians we are here on earth to make a difference. Nehemiah came from a long line of refugee families, separated for generations from their homeland, away from the structures of their religion, forced into slavery in a culture & language they didn't understand. When he learned that his people's homeland was in ruins, hemourned, fasted and prayed. He knew he could do something about that and his prayers turned to plans. The hand of God was upon him. His plans turned to action. In a wonderful way God used him to restore his people and rebuild Jerusalem. There was opposition, but Nehemiah persevered. He trusted himself & his people into God's capable hands. And he acted. Our challenge at Carlingford is to pray, to plan and to act as God leads, for the hand of our God is upon us.
