Nehemiah 5:1-19. Learning and growing through conflict

Last week we discovered that external opposition may not be pleasant but a community can come together and learn how to mutually support each other when persecuted, ridiculed and oppressed by those outside the church. As we finish this short series on Nehemiah we examine the potential damage and division that internal conflict can unleash — indeed it can be a far greater threat.

In many ways the internal conflict in Nehemiah was a rich v poor issue. The walls of Jerusalem were being repaired during a famine – many of those working on the rebuild were struggling to provide food for their families; so much so that there were going into debt and mortgaging their land and crops, and even handing their children over as indentured labourers. The only one's to benefit from this were the wealthy. They were taking advantage of their poorer neighbours and burdening them with loans and the interest on loans that were unjust and against God's laws for the community.. See Levi 25:39-42; Ex 22:25-27

Nehemiah called out this injustice and ordered that these practices be redressed.

We too live in a world where there is a developing chasm between the rich and poor, the haves and have nots. Social justice is at the heart of the Gospel – where is our heart at?

Mission Spot – Power to Change

Nick's story is a great example of how Power to Change connects people to Jesus. He arrived on campus in 2019 with a church background but no active faith. "Academia stressed me out, the fun of parties was incredibly fleeting and I was tired all the time. Yet despite all this, I never gave God a thought. I wanted



to get answers and thought I'd check out something at Uni...I got hooked into a couple of Christian groups and one of them was Power to Change. I got a text message from a guy called Geoff. I said I'd hear him out and that I'd let him tell me his 2 cents, but I'd also bring some questions of my own. I met up with Geoff for a coffee and the first thing I noticed was he was willing to answer my questions. The answers were not what I expected. The answers were intellectually satisfying, they fitted together coherently, but more important than being only logical, they were also emotionally compelling. Every week Geoff told me about a God whose image I bear and who, as the Bible says, loved me and gave Himself up for me. This Gospel, this good news, required a response." Nick has accepted Christ and has gone on to train and lead Christian outreach bringing others to Christ.
