

KIDS HOPE AUS -

Mentoring vulnerable children in Australia Two and a half years ago CBC explored, and

then initiated, training and planning to partner with Kids Hope in a local school. A number of individuals were trained and a coordinator was identified. Then a number of things happened that put the ministry opportunity into mothballs – Covid and a change of Principal in a local school played a significant part in this, plus some people's personal situation and commitments have changed in the past 2.5

Kids Hope have recently contacted us to advise that there is a local school who would be prepared to enter into a Kids Hope partnership with us.

Whilst we still have 3 people who are prepared to be involved with the program it is necessary to provide an individual who would act as a Coordinator in the role. This would necessitate the Coordinator completing a one day training event – either on the 26th October or 29th November, 2022.
