Voice of Marty There are many faithful believers in China, oppressed and closely watched by the Chinese Communist Party. They are forced to make difficult decisions as biblical disciples. These decisions have resulted in imprisonment for Christian church leaders, as well as exile for Christian families and even entire churches. What can we learn from Chinese Christians? To not abandon our faith under any circumstances! Hold on to the precious gift of knowing Christ and what he has done for us.



Many people living under Communist regimes suffer daily for their belief in Christ – in countries such as China, Cuba, Laos, North Korea and Vietnam.

When the leaders of Early Rain Covenant Church in Chengu, China were raided and their Pastor Wang Yi, his wife and others were detained, some members feared that the church would struggle. Instead, the church grew stronger.

The magazine contains many personal stories about the challenge of being faithful followers of Christ and the laws that consider Christianity a cult.
