Türkiye and Syria Devastated By BAPTIST WORLD AID Deadly Earthquakes

What you need to know-

Deaths keep rising— Over 40000 people have died, & the World Health Organisation said this number could rise

People already displaced—The earthquake impacted families who have fled war in Syria and are already dependent on humanitarian aid.

Winter escalates needs—People must find shelter to protect against freezing temperatures and harsh winter conditions.

The 7.8 and 7.5 magnitude earthquakes created over 1,200 aftershocks that damaged or destroyed over 20,000 buildings, leaving many people without shelter or basic supplies in the middle of winter.

Baptist World Aid is working with Christian Partners, including Baptist organisations, to provide emergency aid to families impacted by the earthquakes. The full extent of damage is still not known. join us as we respond to this escalating situation with an outpouring of love.

If we want to end poverty, as we are called to do, we can't ignore or underestimate the importance of caring for and adapting to the changing environment. From the fields of Cambodia and Uganda to the villages of Nepal and Malawi, Baptist World Aid programs have long integrated environmental practices that help communities. Because those most severely affected by environmental crisis such as natural disasters, loss of natural resources and sea level rise are those who have contributed least to them.

The immediate effects of disasters are compounded when a country has a large population living in poverty, so it's natural that our first thought is to react and respond to immediate needs with food, temporary shelter, and emergency healthcare. But responding to disasters only as they happen without addressing issues such as climate change, which can have a huge impact on the frequency and severity of environmental crises, just isn't sustainable long-term.

"There is no question that we must act now to prevent climate change and environmental degradation from undoing decades of good development," says Laura Fontaine, Baptist World Aid International Programs Manager and Climate Change Adviser. "Integrating climate change elements in our programs is fundamental to building resilient and sustainable livelihoods in the communities we partner with."


