All these things are a wonderful use of time but for those of us who are Christians, these events are enjoyed against the background of something far more significant. It is fascinating in the secular world in which we live, when Christianity has

such a tarnished reputation and receives such intolerance and at times abuse, that the media will always have a special focus on the church services conducted on Good Friday and Easter Sunday, will comment on the crowds attending services and have voice grabs of messages preached or interview church leaders about the meaning of Easter.

There is something about the Easter message that resonates with people of faith, people of a jaded faith or even people without a faith. MAF is the only air service with permanent access to the region, which is strictly controlled to protect the traditional indigenous communities. They have earned their trust and respect and have been adopted into the traditional kinship system. They support initiatives to produce locally grown food, presenting a healthy alternative to the longer-lasting processed products, which many Yolngu depend on because of limited access to fresh produce. The epidemic of type-2 diabetes, which has claimed so many lives, is being managed and communities are receiving education about basic healthcare and sustainability. MAF staff in Arnhem Land regularly lead evangelistic outreach and support Bible translation work.Unpaved roads and long distances between the communities make road travel a dangerous, time consuming and arduous task. During the wet season these roads flood and are impassable for months at a time. It's not just about food, water, and a safe place to live, but about health and education and transformation of communities & seeing them thrive. It's about taking Jesus


