TNva411 Muana and Villy - Pastoral Support (Non Tax-Deductible)

Muana invests significant time visiting rural faith communities and churches that are located three hours away. He does this in addition to being Team Leader and supporting our broader team in-country. Muana visiting each church and faith community ensures they have access to pastoral support. He also encourages leaders as they lead their faith communities. He does this three weekends per month. The

team has been partnering with the Church of Christ in



Thailand ever since our work began in Thailand. Through this relationship, the church provides Muana and Villy and family with visas. As part of the agreement, Muana provides pastoral support to two churches that do not have a pastor. In addition to preaching and looking after the spiritual lives of the members, he conducts religious ceremonies for them, including those communion, baptism and funerals. This is one aspect of his ministry. He combines these visits with visiting the funerals. This is one aspect of his ministry. He combines these visits with visiting the Faith Communities in Baan Luang and Baan Sra to encourage them in their active ministry among their communities. These churches and Faith Communities are 3 hours drive away from where Muana, Villy and their family live.

2. MMM Where Most Needed (Tax-Deductible)

This fund provides tax deductible funds for Baptist Mission Australia to use in projects across the range of countries where they minister and which require specific financial

support over and above what churches and individuals provide. (NB. A tax deductible receipt for donations to this fund will be send by Baptist Mission Australia before 30 June 2023).

MISSION SPOT—. **HELP, Samaritan Children's Home (Bangladesh)**

As early as 1990 David and Namita Halder had a vision to improve the lives of disadvantaged children in Bangladesh. Today HELP includes accommodation and a school to care for children with the love of God





and the skills and education for a positive future for themselves and their community. To improve the care and environment for the children the Home is in the process of building an Electric Power Substation in the compound. Over the last 6 months the home has been experiencing fluctuations of electricity at the compound causing damage to some of the electronic equipment. The project aims to ensure that children have access to uninterrupted and stable electricity, which is crucial for their safety, and education as well as office work. A staff member Karno Kanto Bormaon is currently undergoing treatment for liver cancer and is experiencing improvement in his health condition. An answer to prayer. Please continue to pray for him and give thanks that all the children have recovered from Chicken Pox.

The teachers recently had a time away together at the beach from which they have hopefully returned refreshed and ready to assist in the education of the children. Please pray for the challengers they face with rising costs and their ongoing responsibility to the children and their families.


