MISSION SPOT—MAF

MAF are celebrating 50 years in Arnhem Land. A lot of places MAF

serves are by invitation only. Many of the traditional homelands are separated by vast distances with the Yolgnu communities not having the resources to cross these distances, creating isolation.

"Australia is a country of extremes-but nowhere is that more apparent than in Arnhem Land. The heat, the humidity, big weather changes, the logistics, the people, the culture, the language (35 dialects). It's a lot to adjust to, especially with a young family.

It's a part of the world that doesn't get a whole lot of attention, but the needs are just as great as many third world countries-in some places more so. There's people here that need to know the love of Jesus and need access to essential services, like education and medical help. There's some days I don't love everything about my job, but what keeps us going is Jesus! God knows every Indigenous person and loves them-and he calls me to love them too."

Shawn Burarrwanga's grandmother worked as a Yolgnu educator, impacting many young people's lives. Because of her work, the successful SHEP(Secondary Homelands Education Project) continues to run, helping to educate and support students from the surrounding remote areas. "Our children get to know what work is available outside the homeland. It helps them find career pathways from an early age." Shawn Burarrwanga (Laynhapuy Homelands)[9x Homelands served, 160 Current students]. MAF partners their work.

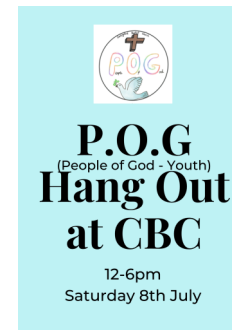
