It was very special for Natalie to return in May, to Ukarumpa in PNG, to run training sessions for the laboratory and nursing staff at the clinic there: The plan has always been to return every year to run these sessions, so to see it finally happen was a huge praise. The lab I work at in Cairns helped me prepare a little 'show and tell' kit of blood films and intestinal parasites (EEWW right? But parasites are "my thing" that I love sharing my knowledge of and enthusiasm for. They were a huge hit during our training sessions.)

I have been making numerous trips to and from Brisbane to establish procedures and to discover breaking points. I have been having meetings at the base with different mission partners to work through the details in order to establish all the links we need to be able to support different missions in PNG. Through all of this I've witnessed and I've been amazed to see how God draws different missions together with all the right people in His timing to make things happen. It's always humbling knowing that it is really not up to me to make everything perfect and I've learnt to rest in the understanding that God knows how to support His missions better than I do. The end goal is to be able to provide aircraft support out of Cairns for medivacs, safety and emergency support, passenger movements and freight in a timely manner and be able to meet the larger needs with sea freight.

James has regained his currency to fly. Due to Covid a lot of pilots lost their currency (all licenses/ratings up to date) and there was a backlog of pilots needing testing to be done.
