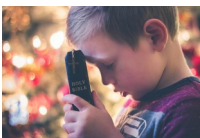

-Timor Leste medivac 222 patients. On a total of 202 flights. That is one person saved around every 1.5 days!

-Uganda's busiest airstrip, Kajjansi 1km, kept
